Talk to your...

Neighbors - An idea might be waiting for you, right next door!

Sports Teams - One of the best places to find immediate support and teamwork!

What to Fundraise For:

La Mariposa - We are always looking for general support that we can use to distribute to urgent needs in our projects, our ongoing employment project, caring for our rescued animals/wildlife, and preserving/conserving/expanding the indigenous plant life on our land and in the surrounding community.

Specific Projects - You can always fundraise for a project directly that you feel most connected to. Your sports team can fundraise directly for our sports projects; You could start a book sale for our education & literacy projects; an environmental club or science class or science fair could raise money for our Santiago Community Garden Project... the possibilities are endless!

Individual Items - We often have individual items or short, one-time needs that we need fulfilled. For example, we just raised money to build a fence to protect kids and relatively pricey soccer balls from the busy street. We also raised money to buy a living fence for our community gardens. Money was donated to buy a pair of oxen to bring water up to the impoverished community of Panama. Letter of Sponsorship *for* La Mariposa

Eco-hotel/Spanish School & Community Development Project

I am currently raising money for La Mariposa, an eco-hotel and Spanish school located in the pueblo San Juan de La Concepcion in the district of Masaya, Nicaragua. The school was started as one method of directly supporting an impoverished area of Nicaragua, while promoting cross-cultural education to begin breaking down Western systems of development that prevent the country's just and sustainable development.

The school functions with and for the community – completely not for profit. All of its money goes into running the hotel, paying the employees well above standard wages, and into its community development projects. While Mariposa does its best to live minimally, it depends on the support of friends and their extended community to consistently maintain their work, through low season and hard times.

With its organic farms and environmentally friendly construction, La Mariposa is constantly working to be self-sustaining. It actively preserves the natural environment, including animal/wildlife rescue and reforestation. While a critical part of who they are is their natural surroundings, the primary goal is to directly serve the people of the community in San Juan. Foremost, Mariposa employs as many people in the community as possible, working to guarantee constant and justly-paid jobs. In addition, they have a number of ongoing projects throughout the community. Here are a few of their current efforts:

Santiago Day Care Project – A daycare project that allows parents to work without worrying about their young ones.

Santiago Reading Project – A library for kids that have little access to books. Kids can borrow books & get excited to read!

Santiago Pila Project – Cleaning out a giant, water-holding reciprocal to collect rainwater for a water-strapped community.

Santiago Community Garden Project – Working with the town hall to create organic community gardens for 26 families.

Ruben Dario School Reading Project – A school library to help with literacy and get kids excited about reading.

Youth Sports Project – Expanding and assisting a local sports league with equipment, tournaments, and prizes.

Panama Water Project – Supplying a pair of oxen to help bring water up to the impoverished and water-less barrio.

Organic Farm – Our personal organic farm to make La Mariposa more self-sustainable.

Animal/Wildlife Project – Rescuing endangered, local wildlife and animals in the community; providing veterinary services.

Reforestation – Collect threatened, indigenous plant life/trees, and plant in/give them to the community.

Bee Project – Supporting a local bee project in Palo Solo, including equipment and training.

These are just a few ways that La Mariposa is supporting the community.
